Paul's gospel is the unveiling of God's hidden wisdom that declares to all, (mankind, the angels, and the devil himself) just how it is that God will accomplish His eternal purposes through the Lord Jesus Christ. God's eternal purpose is laid out for us in Eph. 1:10 "That in the dispensation of the fullness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:"

I Cor. 2:7 & 8 declare that had Satan known this hidden wisdom, (the mystery, Paul's gospel) he would not have crucified the Lord.

Col. 2:15 tells us that the cross lays bare the folly and the utter defeat of Satan and his plan of evil. We do not want to be ignorant of Paul's gospel for in it are the unsearchable riches of Christ that display the power and majesty of the wisdom of God!

Lesson 95 Words Associated with Paul's Gospel

Rom. 1:1 "Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God."

We have been studying Paul's gospel over the last several weeks. Let's take a look at some of the different words that Paul uses in association with the word gospel.

1. **Gospel of God** In Rom. 1:1 we read that Paul was separated unto the _____ of _____. In vs. 2 we read that this was promised afore by his _____ and in the holy _____. In vs. 3 we see that this gospel of God concerns his Son _____ who was made of the seed of _____ according to the flesh. These verses are not contradicting the verses that speak of Paul's gospel as a "mystery" and not prophesied in the Old Testament, (Eph.3:2,3.) I believe, Paul in Rom. 1:2 is referring to the many scriptures in the O.T. that declare God's intention to provide salvation for mankind, not Paul's "specific" gospel. In Gen. 3:15 God declares to Satan, "...it shall bruise thy _____, and thou shalt bruise his _____." God has always provided for mankind's salvation. The "gospel of God" speaks of God as the author, the originator of the gospel, the wonderful, glorious news that He has for mankind. Rom. 1:3-5 goes on to proclaim that Paul is going to proclaim Christ. And we know that it is the further, secret revelation concerning Christ, that Paul's gospel is centered in.
2. **Gospel of Christ** In II Cor. 10:14 we read "...for we are come as far as to you also in preaching the _____ of _____:" Paul's gospel is about Christ, His sacrifice, His love, His resurrection, His life imparted, forgiveness, acceptance, adoption, justification, righteousness through Him! Paul's writings are all about Christ! I Cor. 2:2 "For I determined not to know anything among you, save _____ and him _____." Rom. 15:19 "...I have fully preached the _____ of _____." I Cor. 9:12 "...lest we should hinder the _____ of _____." Paul uses the phrase "gospel of Christ" many times. Christ is at the center, the heart, of all that God revealed to Paul.
3. **Gospel of the Grace of God** Acts 20:24 "...and the ministry which I have _____ of the _____ to _____ the _____ of the _____ of _____." Paul's special message was all about God's grace, apart from the deeds of the law, saving, forgiving, justifying, and reconciling mankind. Eph. 2:8 "For by _____ are ye _____..." Rom. 3:24 "Being _____ freely by his _____..." Titus 2:11 "For the _____ of God that bringeth _____..." God's grace is His declaration to mankind today. In all of Paul's epistles we find the words "grace and peace". Grace is what God is extending to the world today. Grace that saves Eph. 2:8, grace that teaches Titus 2:12, grace that builds us up Acts 20:32. Eph. 1:7 "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the _____ of his _____." Eph. 2:7 "That in the ages to come he might shew the _____ of his _____..." God's grace is full of riches. All the riches of God's grace are purely a work of God for man built solely on the merit of the Lord Jesus Christ. I love what Chafer says, "Because the riches of God's grace are built on the merit of Christ we can be sure that they are as abiding as the merit on which they rest."
4. **Glorious Gospel** I Tim. 1:11 "According to the _____ of the blessed God which was _____ to _____ trust." II Cor. 4:4 "...lest the light of the _____ of Christ..." Paul's gospel is indeed glorious! It reveals the glory of God! Nothing in all of scripture rivals God's glory displayed in all it's wisdom, might, majesty and power in Paul's gospel. Read II Cor. 3:6-18. How many times does Paul use the word glory or glorious? _____ Eph. 1:6 "To the praise of the _____ of his _____..." God shewed his glory over and over again in the O. T. Remember when Moses asked God to shew him His glory? Ex. 33:18 "And he said, I beseech thee, shew me thy _____." In vs. 19 we see that God's glory is seen in His _____.

The goodness of God manifests His glory! In vs. 21, 22 God puts Moses in a _____ of a _____ vs. 22 and he covers him with His _____. Moses saw God's "back parts". He only saw a part, a portion of God. The cleft of a rock where Moses was protected and hid during this time I believe is a type of Christ. It is in Christ that we behold the glory of God. Now, in the dispensation of grace, we behold as none before us, the glory of God. We reside in Christ and He in us, Paul's gospel is the great unveiling of God's goodness and it is there that we behold the glory of God!

5. **Gospel of Your Salvation** Eph. 1:13 "In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the _____ of _____..." Salvation, what a powerful word. How sad so many deny any need for salvation. God has offered salvation to his creation from Adam on down. Paul's gospel is all about God's salvation for the dispensation of grace, our salvation!
6. **Gospel of the Uncircumcision** Gal. 2:7 "But contrariwise, when they saw that the _____ of the _____..." Eph. 2:11 defines the uncircumcision as _____. Yes, Gentiles, those who in Eph. 2:2 were without _____ being _____ from the commonwealth of Israel, and _____ from the _____ of _____ having _____ hope, and _____ in the world. God's message to the Gentiles, the world, now with no difference between Jew and Gentile. Acts 28:28 "Be it known therefore unto you, that the _____ of _____ is sent unto the _____, and that they will hear it."
7. **Gospel of Peace** Eph. 6:15 "And your feet shod with the _____ of _____;" Paul's gospel is all about Christ making peace between sinful man and God. Rom. 5:1 "Therefore being justified by faith, we have _____ through our Lord Jesus Christ." Eph. 2:14-17 vs. 14 "For _____ is our _____..." vs. 16 "and that he might _____ both unto God in one body by the _____..." vs. 17 "And came and preached _____ to you that were _____ off, and to them that were nigh." Col. 1:20 "And having made _____ through the _____ of his _____..." Paul's gospel also imparts inward peace. Phil. 4:7 "And the _____ of God which passeth all understanding shall _____ your _____ and _____ through Christ Jesus."
8. **Another Gospel** Gal. 1:6 "I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto _____" II Cor. 11:4 "...or _____ gospel..." Paul warns us about another gospel. Any other gospel that denies the sufficiency of grace alone to save, keep, edify, teach and perfect is not Paul's gospel. Any other gospel that adds human merit to grace denies the truth of Paul's gospel. Some may say we make "too much" of Paul's gospel. When we understand that God puts the "spotlight" on the "mystery", His "hidden wisdom" that reveals His eternal purposes centered in His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, we will hunger for more knowledge of Him!
